Earnings from the Birch Creek Endowment supplement annual revenue while Endowment principal continues to grow. A minimum gift of \$5,000 is required to open a sub-fund that will bear the name of a donor or designee. By opening a sub-fund, gifts may be accrued without limit.

Wonderful naming opportunities are available for friends and benefactors who seek to insure that the highest quality of music education and performance will be available for future generations. These opportunities begin when a sub-fund's account value reaches \$20,000. At that time a scholarship, faculty or staff chair, or a secondary campus facility may be permanently named.

Gifts of less than \$5,000 are pooled with gifts of similar value from other donors in one of the four Endowment Funds identified above at the donor's preference.
